








### **GEOGRAPHIC FEATURES**



- Municipality of Neapoli-Sykies was formed under the Law 3852/2010 and is consisted of the former Municipalities of Ag.Pavlos, Neapoli, Sykies and Pefka.
- Geographically it belongs to the Region of Central Macedonia and occupies the northern part of the Metropolitan area of the City of Thessaloniki.
- The total population is 84,741 inhabitants and its total surface is 12.903 km<sup>2</sup>.

### Our main deliverables

- One (1) Project publicity event (Opening Conference)
- Contribution to the Joint Strategy and the Local Action Plan
- Organisation of one awareness seminar and two special workshops
- Prepare and run the Local Pilot in our Municipality, as proof-ofconcept and real conditions testing of the Cross4all technologies and resources
- Acquisition of equipment for the Local Center (info points and devices for preventive health checks) and for the mobile / telemonitoring programme
- Implementation of the Pilot Programme incl. the operation of the Mobile Unit





## Our draft procurement plans

- First Level Control: 5.000€ (incl. VAT)
- Equipment: 50.900,00€ (incl. VAT)
- External expertise for the Pilot Programme: 99.300,00€ (incl. VAT)
- Consulting services (training, events, ...): 25,817,00€ (incl. VAT)



## Short term plans (6 months)

- Assign staff to the project
- Prepare the tender for the consulting services
- Organise the opening conference
- Participate to the project study visits



## Local project coordination and management

- Local Project and Financial Manager: Responsible for the management of the project (reporting, monitoring, etc.) - Part time (approx. 5 hrs per month)
- Local Project Manager Assistant: To be hired to support the LPM -Part time (approx. 35%)
- Coordinator of the Local Pilot Programme (full-time 6-7 months)
